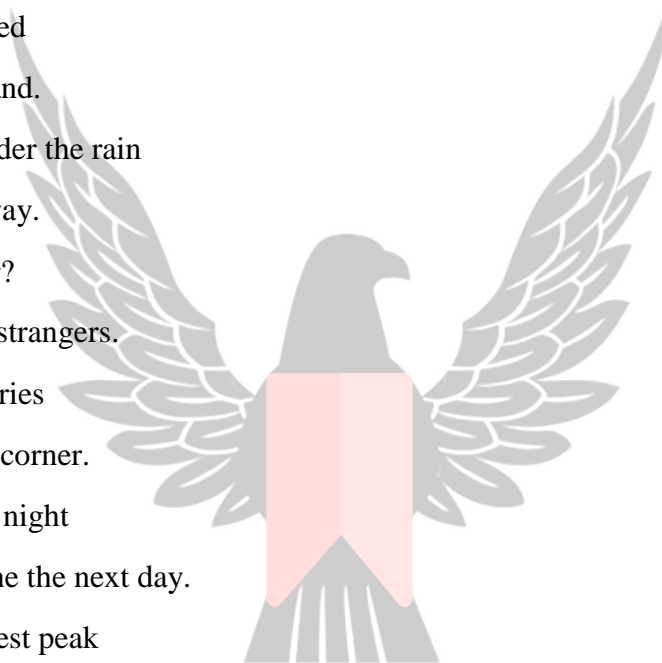

There are some things or people in every person's life, to whom they can't thank for their contribution;

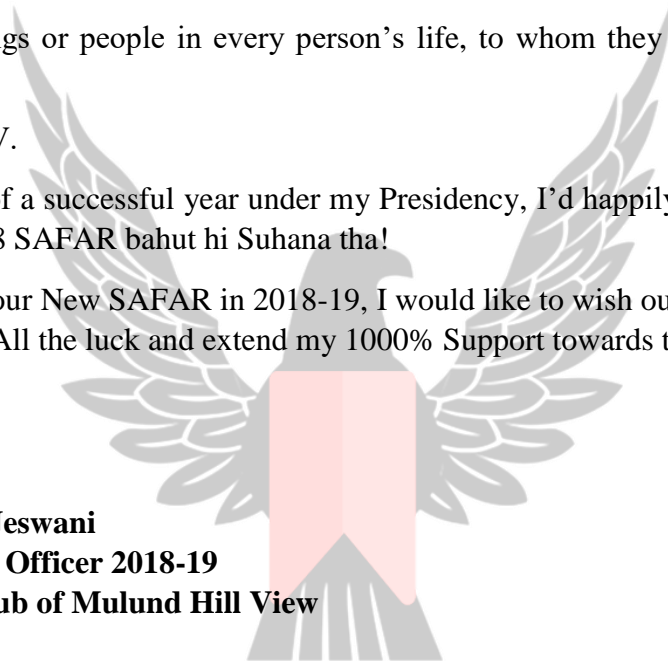
For me, it's RCMHV.

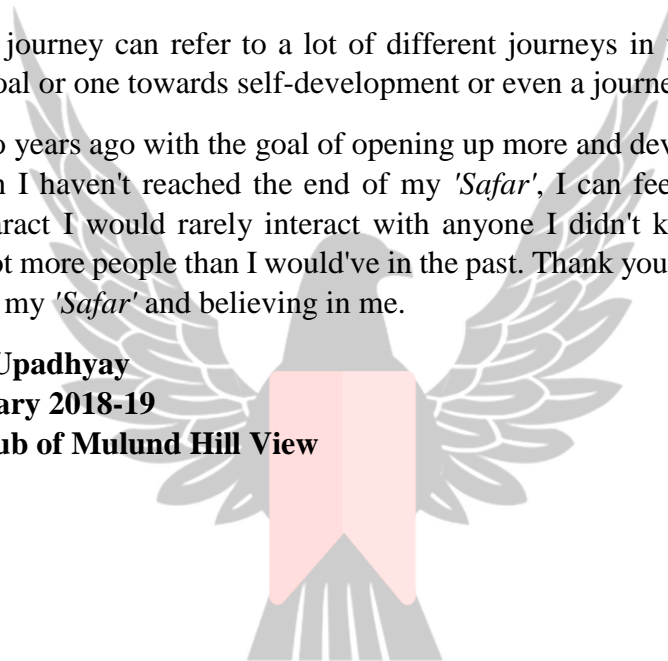
